WEST VALLEY CITY COUNCIL APPROVES JORDAN RIVER MARKETPLACE DEVELOPMENT

In the West Valley City Council Meeting, Tuesday September 1, Mayor Dennis Nordfelt, the City Council and the Redevelopment Agency reached a majority decision to approve the Jordan River Marketplace Development.
