Ascent Construction, Inc. Completes the Renovation of an Historic Browning Farmhouse in Ogden, Utah

Ascent Construction, Inc. (Ascent) recently completed a four-month restoration project of the Historic Browning Home through Weber County Parks and Recreation. This project is not the typical construction project that Ascent usually completes. This project was truly a unique opportunity. The Browning Home was originally built in 1874 using handmade nails and local brick. The cedar clad farmhouse was first located at #4 Old Post Road next to Birch Creek and has since been moved to Fort Buenaventura to serve as an educational focal point.

It served as one of the first post offices in the area. Restoration of the 365 SF home included structural repair, plaster repair, replacement of deteriorated materials, retaining structural integrity, adding electrical and attaching the home to its new foundation.
