### West Valley City Redevelopment Agency Approves Developer for Jordan River Marketplace

In April of this year, the West Valley City Redevelopment Agency (RDA) sent more than a hundred requests for proposals, seeking an ideal development team to design, develop, and construct the City's long awaited Jordan River Marketplace. The development complements the mission of the Utah Cultural Celebration Center by providing a cultural marketplace that will occupy the property south of the Center at approximately 1400 West 3100 South. On Tuesday, September 2, 2008, the City Council gave the go-ahead for the RDA staff members to move forward and immediately start working with Ascent Construction on this unique development which has the potential to define West Valley City for generations to come.



The Ascent Construction team, headed by Brad L. Knowlton, Developer Contractor, has the passion, vision, financial backing, experience, and development ability to make this project a reality for the City with construction starting in the spring of 2009. Their team will work collaboratively together with the JRM RDA Project Manager, Ralph K. Lee, West Valley City leadership and other community stakeholders as a unified team that will make this proposed vision a reality.
