Emigration Canyon Community Celebrates Their New Fire Station

The heavy snow fall and icy roads did not keep the local residents of Emigration Canyon from attending the ribbon-cutting ceremony on December 13th for their new fire station. The new Emigration Fire Station #119, located at 5025 E. Emigration Canyon Road is a welcome relief to residents who have worried about their families and homes for years because of the lack of emergency fire services. The long-awaited fire station was welcomed and celebrated by nearly 200 local residents, Unified Fire representatives, representatives of Ascent Construction, and city and government officials who attended the ceremony and toured the new facility.

The Emigration Fire Station #119 is a beautiful 2-story, 2-bay, 10,440 SF fire station serving the Emigration Canyon area. It includes a fire pole from the second to the first story, a workout room with a rubberized floor, dorm areas, large break room, outdoor deck and a kitchen area. The entrance to the facility includes aluminum doors surrounded by hand-stained glass and a stamped concrete floor. Heating, automated doors, exterior lighting and high-pressure water and air lines are provided for the apparatus bays.

The exterior of the facility is fully landscaped surrounded by natural rock retaining walls and a full concrete parking bay entrance. The facility also includes aluminum clad wood windows, a self-contained backup power system and metal roof structure. The facility is built from steel trussing, fiber cement siding and stone veneer. Flooring inside the facility includes rubber matting, tile, carpet and concrete.

The design of this Fire Station is not like most fire station projects, it resembles a ski lodge set back on the hillside—fitting perfectly into the area. The Architect on the project was Bill Gould of Pasker Gould Ames & Weaver of Murray, Utah.
