Ascent Construction, Inc. Receives Distinguished “Best of Category” Varco-Pruden Award for the FedEx Building in Vineyard

Ascent Construction, Inc., headquartered in Centerville, was recently named the “Best of Category” winner for the “distribution” category in the 2008 VP Buildings Hall of Fame. The distinguished Varco-Pruden building award was for the 66,300 SF, pre-engineered steel, FedEx Ground Package Systems facility located at 576 East 1750 North, Vineyard, Utah.

The FedEx Ground Package Systems facility is built on 11 acres and is used to process and stage FedEx ground shipments for the Utah territory. It incorporates a state-of-the-art, fully automatic conveyer system and 3,860 SF of office space. Wainscoting and full landscaping which includes an erosion system surrounds the building.

The FedEx facility was built for Scannell Properties. Regarding the FedEx project, Robert Cseresznyes, Development Manager of Scannell Properties, said, “I have heard nothing but high praises from everyone involved in this project. You should be very proud of your accomplishments.”

The National Hall of Fame Awards are presented each year to authorized VP Builders for outstanding integration of building systems, products and design. The 2008 Hall of Fame Awards included hundreds of winning entries in the following categories: agriculture, auto dealership, churches, fast track, government buildings, aviation buildings, distribution, hybrid, manufacturing facilities, offices, recreational facilities, retail buildings, retrofit roofing, self storage buildings, schools, warehouses and miscellaneous. Over 1,000 authorized builders from across the globe are eligible to enter multiple categories in the Hall of Fame competition. This year, 91 projects were selected to receive Hall of Fame status.
